1 ATTENDANCE

1.1 59 Participants

2 ATTENDANCE

The Chairman (KVH) welcomed all participants at 17:15. There were 59 participants in the zoom meeting. KVH stated that the KOSRA Constitution requires the meeting to have 15% of the members present. It was noted that 59 participants met the requirements.

3 FORMATLIES

3.1 2019 KOSRA AGM minutes were published on the website last year. Dave Hidden nominated the minutes for approval. Marianna Ferreira seconded this.

3.2 There were no matters arising from the previous minutes.

3.3 2019 KOSRA Financial statement were published on the website last year. Stuart Clarkson nominated the Financial statements for approval. Pollos Purdon seconded this.

4 2021 COMMITTEE MEMBERS

4.1 KVH read out the 12 nominated committee members as listed at the end of the minutes.

4.2 A poll was submitted and 98% of participants voted 'Yes' to the appointment of the 2021 Committee.

5 GENERAL

5.1 KVH noted that 2020 tumultuous year in many respects for the committee, the country and Kenton-on Sea.

5.2 KVH mentioned that prior to the meeting Ndlambe retracted their position with regards to the use of the rivers under the Covid regulations.

- 5.4 The area which is to be known as river can be described as the area North of a line drawn from the BRM car park past RO plant over the Bushmans River to the rocks Kenton side. The river is available to be used. This is to be used in accordance with Covid regulations. Social distancing and protocols to be adhered to at all times.
- 5.5 KVH mentioned that there are few court challenges which are pending regarding the beach restrictions. It was hoped that these would have successful outcomes.
- 5.6 Kenton News agency commented: Congratulations to KVH for the letter that was sent out to the Mayor today. They were proud to be a member of KOSRA. ??

6 KENTON SAND DUNE

- 6.1 KVH introduced the topic of the Kenton Sand Dune: This has been a topic in peoples' minds for quite a number of years. The sand dune under discussion is at the bottom of Westbourne road. KVH has had discussions with Robert Rose (KSDNA) and has listened and learnt many different perspectives.
- 6.2 KVH noted that KOSRA had not previously lodged a formal objection to KSDNA proposal, however Estuary Care had submitted an objection and had lodged an appeal. This outcome of this is still pending.
- 6.3 Members of KOSRA are now able to listen to both sides of the situation and form their own opinions.
- 6.4 Members we referred to the presentation notes from KSDNA (Robert Rose) and the presentation notes from EC (Stuart Clarkson).
- 6.5 Robert Rose noted that KSDNA have tried to work with EC in the last 5 years. RR mentioned that EC was not interested in any other suggestions other than opening up Dry Bones Valley. RR urged that EC, locals and members listen to the consultants and the alternative options. RR would like KSDNA and EC to turn over a new leaf and work together for everyone's benefit.
- 6.6 RR also mentioned the silting of the river and that the sand accumulation will need to be dredged.
- 6.7 Jane H: Thanked both RR and SC for their presentations. It would be good to have both organizations to work together and that both parties come to an agreement which is suitable for both organizations. KVH agrees.

KVH thanked all for attending and closed the meeting.
