Municipal Skips in Kenton on Sea

KOSRA has received several complaints from residents about the location of the municipal skips in Kenton on Sea.

The skips are, at present, located in close proximity to the residential apartments at the Tradewind Centre. The continual noise of municipal workers, lorries loading and unloading plus bottles being broken as waste is dumped is causing great distress to the residents. Dumping in the skips takes place at all hours of the day and night often making it difficult for the residents to sleep.

There is also the very concerning issues of smell, vermin and stray animal at the skips making this location a severe health and safety problem.

We request that the skips are moved immediately to a new location away from residential properties. We would suggest that the municipal land adjacent to the police station would be an ideal location as it is easily accessible and will not be a noise and health and safety issue.
